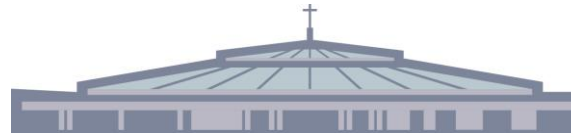

A UGANDAN EXPERIENCE

Fr Fabius sends the parishioners of Eastwood his affectionate greetings and appreciation for the clothes and money that has been kindly contributed.

Fr Fabius and I distributed the clothes to the women returning home from work in the fields. There were looks of disbelief. I said, 'Everyone deserves a new dress sometimes!' Some of them have babies and older children. They were able to receive clothing as well. We visited a pre-school and primary school in materially poor rural areas. Some of the children were orphans. They received the six homemade skirts sewed by a St. Kevin parishioner. They couldn't believe it when I told them, 'You can keep them.' The pre-school children received the green/gold undergarments also made by another parishioner – they loved them! Most of the children don't have uniform, shoes or exercise books. The teacher asked, 'How many have brought lunches?' No more than four students, regardless of class size in all classes visited, put up their hands. Most of them don't get more than one meal each day.

After a meeting with the headmaster, Fr Fabius and I decided that the money donated by our parishioners would go towards the construction of a temporary outdoor kitchen. Maize porridge will be cooked there so at least the children will have a daytime meal. Fr Fabius turned to me saying, "What do you think, will they approve?" It was a resounding "Yes!" Fr Fabius said anyone interested in visiting Uganda will be warmly welcomed.... and just go with the flow! - *Marissa Pongan, St. Kevin's Parishioner*
