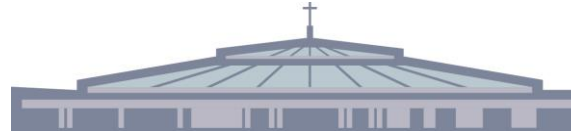

"Whoever is not against us is for us"; these insightful words came from the mouth of Jesus of Nazareth in Luke's Gospel. These words shocked the first disciples as I am sure they would still shock many Christian followers today!

There are so many people from secular organizations throughout the world who are doing their best to relieve others who are suffering and need support. It is a fair comment to make that many of these people are not consciously moved by the spirit of God in what they are doing. They often work in organizations beyond the boundaries of the Catholic Church or any other faith or religious centered group. These groups include the Red Cross, Alcoholics Anonymous, Rotary International and Medical Frontiers. It is important to remember that the mission and the great work of groups I have mentioned are somehow connected with the ongoing work of the body of Christ in the world. These groups do so much in being an instrument of healing and service in the world which in indirect ways is also truly Christ like. This is the point that Jesus made to his first disciples when they saw people other than themselves healing and supporting others.

The difference for us to remember is that when people serve others in the Catholic Church they are doing so with good will but hopefully also with the invisible strength gained from the Church's sacraments. - Fr Martin R Maunsell

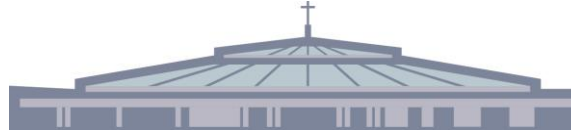
