### LEADERS are often READERS!

Many historians rate *Harry S Truman (1884-1972)* as one of the great Presidents of the United States. His rise to the office of President was extraordinary in that he had no university education and after military service he had a failed business career. After this he then entered into politics where he definitely rose to the top!

One of President Truman's most insightful of sayings amidst many was; *"that not all readers are leaders in life but just about every leader is a reader."* Harry Truman was a voracious reader and he comprehended so well what he read. He was blessed with a towering natural intellect. He often said that the skill in making effective diplomatic and political decisions so often necessitated being well read on the issues and the people at hand.

Some of the benefits of being a wide reader is that it is often the means of building up a good vocabulary of words, assimilating new information and often increasing emotional intelligence and stability. Also another benefit of reading is that almost everyone can have access to books.

History has often revealed that so many bad decisions have been made in many fields of life because of an ignorance of vital knowledge.
