Oscar is best remembered for his biting wit and wisdom and a master story telling. Perhaps his best play was *The Importance of Being Earnest* and his bestselling novel was *The picture of Dorian Gray*. Below are some of his most memorable quotes;

- Always make a conscious effort to openly forgive your enemies as experience has shown that noting will annoy them more!*
