



PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES WHEN VISITING THE CHURCH:

- *Physical distancing must be observed whenever possible. Attendees may sit only in marked places. Family members living in the same household may sit together.*
- *A fitted face mask must be worn in places of public worship to help prevent the transmission of COVID-19. Children 12 years and under are exempt but are encouraged to wear masks where practicable.*
- *Parishioners who are unwell or have been in contact with any known Covid-19 case or visited a place or establishment confirmed to have COVID-19 cases, must go home & get tested. Follow the NSW Health advice and check the latest COVID-19 case locations in NSW: <https://www.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/latest-news-and-updates>*
- *Attendees must observe good hygiene practices.*
- *Contact details of all those entering the church including name, phone number and check-in/out time must be recorded by using the NSW Government issued QR CODE. Parishioners without the technology to scan the QR code can register manually. QR CODE check-in is mandatory.*
- *If you are going to use the pens in the foyer, we ask that you sanitise your hands before and after you register. You may bring your own pen to use at registration. Hand sanitisers and disinfectant wipes are also provided.*
- *There will be no hand-to-hand passing of parish bulletins or collection plates.*
- *The sign of peace should be without any physical contact.*
- *Priests, Deacons, Senior Servers, and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are to wear face masks prior to distributing Holy Communion.*
- *Holy Communion shall be received by hand only.*
- *The NSW Government has announced that fully vaccinated members of the congregation are permitted to sing, but masks must still be worn.*
- *We humbly ask everyone to clean their seats after Mass using the disinfectant wipes provided on selected pews. As a matter of courtesy, please wait until the Mass is officially over and the recessional hymn is done before we start cleaning. Please place used wipes in the bins at the back row. As part of our COVID-Safe plan, the pews need to be cleaned regularly. Extra cleaning supplies are provided at the back of the church, near the sacristy.*
- *Congregants are discouraged to crowd or gather outside the church for too long at the end of each service.*
